Ang Misyon was founded in 2012 by FPH Chairman Federico R. Lopez, ABS-CBN Corporation Chairman Eugenio Lopez III, and Concert Pianist Jovianney Emmanuel Cruz.

Joshua Dos Santos graduated from El Sistema, a globally renowned music program originating in Venezuela. He trained under its founder, Maestro Jose Antonio Abreu. Joshua made his conducting debut at 16 years old and is considered one of the most versatile conductors of this generation.

The **Orchestra of the Filipino Youth (OFY)** is an ensemble of young musicians from mostly underprivileged families across Luzon and Visayas. Its members are hand-picked for their talent, passion, and need.

Since its inception in 2012, OFY scholars have rendered over 100 performances in various locations in the Philippines & abroad.

How does Ang Misyon Work?

The organization provides programs and services designed to benefit its scholars and stakeholders.

These include access to:

- Professional music lessons and materials based on a 2.5-year curriculum
- Instrument support
- Values formation and counseling
- Opportunities for local and International performances
- Opportunities to serve as junior mentors to younger scholars

QUICK FACTS ABOUT ANG MISYON:

- SEC & DSWD Registered, Accredited by PCNC (Philippine Council for NGO Certification)
- Age range: 6 years old to 21 years old and above (From Beginners to OFY Associates)
- Primarily consists of Male scholars (57%), while Female scholars are at 43%
- Majority of our scholars are from modest, underprivileged, or disadvantaged communities.

Ang Misyon Children's Orchestra (AMCO) is the group of younger scholars in the music program who show musical promise but requires more training in playing their instrument. Most scholars from AMCO move upward to play for the Orchestra of the Filipino Youth.
